Description: The funding is being provided through USDA's Rural Energy for America Program (REAP), which was created under the 2008 Farm Bill and reauthorized under the 2018 Farm Bill. This notice seeks applications for Fiscal Year 2020 funding. The deadlines to apply for grants are Oct. 31, 2019, and March 31, 2020. Applications for loan guarantees are accepted year-round. REAP helps agricultural producers and rural small businesses reduce energy costs and consumption by purchasing and installing renewable energy systems and making energy efficiency improvements in their operations. Eligible systems may derive energy from wind, solar, hydroelectric, ocean, hydrogen, geothermal or renewable biomass (including anaerobic digesters). USDA encourages applications that will support recommendations made in the Report to the President of the United States from the Task Force on Agriculture and Rural Prosperity to help improve life in rural America.

Regional Conservation Partnership Program

Description: USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) announced the launch of the updated Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP). Potential partners are encouraged to submit proposals that will improve the nation's water quality, combat drought, enhance soil health, support wildlife habitat and protect agricultural viability. RCPP eligible partners include private industry, nongovernment organizations, Indian tribes, state and local governments, water districts and universities. Partners may request between \$250,000 and \$10 million in RCPP funding through this funding announcement. Leveraging of this NRCS funding is a key principle of RCPP; partners are expected to make value-added contributions to amplify the impact of RCPP funding.

CORTEZ MASTO APPLAUDS OVER \$2.7 MILLION FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT IN NEVADA

Las Vegas, Nev. – U.S. Senator Catherine Cortez Masto (D-Nev.) released the following statement applauding the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for



awarding grants totaling over \$2.7 million for community development and affordable housing in Las Vegas and Sparks.

"As one of the fastest-growing states in the nation, Nevada continues to experience an affordable housing crisis. These grants provide crucial support for Nevadans struggling to maintain a safe and secure home. I'm committed to fighting in the Senate to make sure our communities have both affordable housing and flourishing economies."

BACKGROUND:

This package of grants is funded through two programs under the umbrella of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), including the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and the Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) program. The grant funds will be awarded across Nevada as follows:

- The City of Las Vegas will receive \$2,088,532.
- Sparks will receive \$691,196.

CORTEZ MASTO CELEBRATES OVER \$9 MILLION FOR BRIDGE REPAIRS ON I-515

Reno, Nev. – U.S. Senator Catherine Cortez Masto (D-Nev.) welcomed over \$9 million awarded to the Nevada Department of Transportation for bridge repairs to I-515 to ease travel through downtown Las Vegas. The grant was provided by the Department of Transportation as part of a Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP).

"I-515 is crucial to Las Vegas' economy and for accessibility and travel in Southern Nevada, connecting Henderson to our booming downtown Las Vegas. I'm confident these grants will improve safety, facilitate business and reduce traffic congestion for commuters and residents in Southern Nevada."

BACKGROUND

Through the *Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2018*, Congress made available \$225,000,000 for a Competitive Highway Bridge Program (CHBP) through the U.S. Department of Transportation. The funds must be used for highway bridge replacement and rehabilitation projects on any



public road that demonstrate cost savings by bundling multiple highway bridge projects. States must have a population density of less than 100 individuals per square mile to be eligible.

In this grant through CHBP, the Nevada Department of Transportation was awarded \$9,821,0000 for bridge replacements at multiple locations on I-515.

CORTEZ MASTO APPLAUDS \$1.7 MILLION TO COMBAT VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Reno, Nev. – U.S. Senator Catherine Cortez Masto (D-Nev.) announced over \$1.7 million to help Nevada reduce violence against women. Awarded to the Office of the Nevada Attorney General, the grant funding was provided by the STOP Violence Against Women Formula Grant Program to facilitate coordination between law enforcement, courts and victims services organizations to combat violent crimes against women.

"Since my time as Attorney General, protecting women from violence and strengthening survivors' rights have been my top priorities. This grant will increase our ability to hold perpetrators accountable and create a path for victims of violence to seek justice. Sexual assault, stalking and domestic violence have no place in Nevada or the nation, and I'll continue working to ensure law enforcement and service organizations have all the resources they need to fight this epidemic."

BACKGROUND

The STOP (Services, Training, Officers, Prosecutors) Violence Against Women Formula Grant Program (STOP Formula Grant Program) was authorized by the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) of 1994 and reauthorized by subsequent legislation. The STOP Formula Grant Program encourages partnerships between law enforcement, prosecutors, courts and victim services organizations to enhance victim safety and hold offenders accountable in cases of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking. The goal of the grant program is to develop and strengthen law enforcement, prosecution and court strategies to combat violent crimes against women and to develop and strengthen victim services, including community-based, culturally-specific services, in cases involving domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault and stalking.
